I. Adopt Curriculum for Grades K-8 for Science aligned with Next Generation Science Standards

DESCRIPTION: The District is required to adopt kindergarten through 8th grade instructional materials in science aligned to the Next Generation Science Standards. Spencer Valley teachers and parents evaluated various programs approved by the California Department of Education. Twig Science, by Twig Education, was selected for grades K-5 and Science Bits, by Learning Bits, was selected for grades 5-8.

J. Approve Expanded Learning Opportunities Program Plan

DESCRIPTION: The Expanded Learning Opportunities Program (ELO-P) provides funding for afterschool and summer school enrichment programs for transitional kindergarten through sixth grade. "Expanded learning" means before school, after school, summer, or intersession learning programs that focus on developing the academic, social, emotional, and physical needs and interests of pupils through hands-on, engaging learning experiences. It is the intent of the Legislature that expanded learning programs are pupil-centered, results driven, include community partners, and complement, but do not replicate, learning activities in the regular school day and school year.

BUDGET IMPLICATIONS: \$50,000 for FY21-22 for planning; \$50,000 for FY22-23. **RECOMMENDATION(S):** To approve the Expanded Learning Opportunities Program Plan.
