BACKGROUND: Per State requirements, each school district must submit a Second Interim Budget by March 15th. The Second Interim budget allows Districts and the State an opportunity to respond to the changing budget climate from the time the original budget is approved in June.

BUDGET IMPLICATIONS: The Second Interim budget for 16-17 is a mid year checkin on budgeted revenue and expenditures versus actual revenue and expenditures as of January 31, 2017. Changes in Revenue reflect changes due to the Governor's January budget projections and loss of charter school ADA. Changes in expenditure reflect changes due to actual expenditures.

B. Consolidated Application - Winter submission for 16-17

PROPOSAL: It is proposed that the Governing Board of Spencer Valley School District approve the winter submission for the 2016-2017 Consolidated Application for funding.

BACKGROUND: The Consolidated Application (ConApp) is the form the district uses to apply for state and some Federal funding. Winter Submission includes a spending plan for Economic Impact Aid funding and expenditure of Title II funds. The ConApp was submitted to the state electronically on February 15, 2017.

C. Approve purchase of new IT infrastructure

PROPOSAL: To approve the purchase of new switches and a wireless controller. **BACKGROUND:** To improve existing internal connections for improved internet and to allow for VOIP phone services, a RFP was posted for new switches and a wireless controller. Three bids were returned. The winning bid is from Datel Systems Incorporated. The switches and controller will be installed by the SDCOE. E-rate category 2 funds will reimburse 80% of the cost.

BUDGET IMPLICATIONS: Out of pocket cost is \$1,001 from General Fund. Minimal additional costs for hourly labor to SDCOE for installation.

D. Approve Hosted VoIP Phone System

PROPOSAL: To approve a hosted VoIP phone system from Jive.

BACKGROUND: The current phone system is not working properly and is out of date and unable to be fixed. The current proposal replaces the old phone system with a Hosted VoIP Phone System. Included in the quote are Interconnected VoIP Monthly Charges, and the purchase of wired and wireless phones and loud speakers. The loud speakers will allow for all school announcements and are necessary in times of emergencies. Unlimited incoming and outgoing calls are included.

BUDGET IMPLICATIONS: Monthly recurring charges of \$146.15/month. One time phone and loud speaker purchases of \$2,200.57.
