A. Spencer Valley School Annex – The District met with StudioWC to discuss the water system plans and the needs for fire safety. The annex will need fire sprinklers and

- storage tanks to hold ~44,000 gallons of water. The Superintendent will attend the next Julian Planning Group meeting with project manager Tom Silva.
- B. Health Education Curriculum Framework Information was presented on the updated 2018 Health Curriculum Framework, a guidance document for districts to use when developing health education programs for students. The California Healthy Youth Action of 2016 is a law that requires districts to provide middle school and high school students with comprehensive sexual health education, along with information about HIV prevention. Parents may opt their children out of comprehensive sex education.
